THE BAY LIGHTS

SAN FRANCISCO

Public art reaches new heights at this huge display by artist Leo Villard that illuminates the west span of the San Francisco Oakland Bay Bridge. The 25,000 computer-controlled LED lights react to the motion of the bay water. "The light patterns are never repeating. Every time someone observes it, it's a unique experience," Golding says. DIGITAL GRAFTY

This weekend festival, held May 13-15, attracts artists from around the globe, who take to the open-air community space Paradise City Fla. to project their creations on walls and structures. "You can see windows of digital art suddenly appear and disappear. A pioneer in digital art, the Austrian center features some of the most important works in the medium. One of its earliest exhibits was the short animated film "Lure," a short film about human beings by John Lasseter, who is best known for his work with Pixar. The center's huge digital projection room, called Drop Eye, features high-resolution in 3D and images from inside the human body. "The work is an endless journey," Golding says.
